- II. Approval of January's Meeting Minutes: Erin Cory moves to approve, Jenna Allen seconds. Minutes approved.
- III. Completed or Ongoing Business
 - a. Conference Meals (Feb 7, 8 and 13): Positive feedback on the meals, the healthier options were greatly appreciated.
 - b. Spelling Bee Update: Spelling bee went well, may change up the timing of the bees next year so that there is a larger gap between the grade level bees and school level bee.
 - c. Spring Fundraiser Update (March 4): Ticket sales are down this year, working on spreading the word through flyers and facebook. Promotion of the mustang memories in the school should also help with ticket sales.

 - e. Yearbook Update: Shannon is sending yearbook fliers to go home in folders next week. Business card ad sales are also going out.

IV. New business

a. Coffee in Staff Lounges: Redemption road wanted to partner with the PAC to provide coffee to the school. As not everyone drinks coffee the school has declined the partnership. The PAC is considering having them do a pop-up coffee stand during events such as the harvest moon festival and staff appreciation week. The motion passes unanimously.
